WHAT?

We are glad to present our first open call, as a 2022 special project that will see the participation of a panel of experts. The winner is going to be selected by artist Giulia Cenci, curator Caterina Molteni, gallery owner Francesco Lecci (Clima, Milano), collector Marco Martini and SottoFondo's art managerial. The artists, or collectives, will be evaluated on the base of their portfolio, and might have the chance to carry out a personal exhibition in SottoFondo; our team will assist in the planning, preparation, communication, documentation, and opening of the event. Furthermore the winner is going to be provided a budget of 400€, to use at its own discretion.

The team of SottoFondo reserves the right to contact all applicants in view of further, future collaborations, within the frame of "Lo Studio Ospita" planning series.

WHO?

The call is open to artists and collectives (below 35 years old) from all countries. Every type of medium is welcome, including painting, sculpture, performance, video, installation, and any other art form.

HOW?

From Monday, February 28, interested artists can send their application and portfolio to infosottofondostudio@gmail.com, stating in the subject: NAME, SURNAME, OPEN CALL 2022.

Portfolio must include statement, bio e up-to-date resume; add links to personal websites or projects' videos if these can support a deeper understanding of your proposal. Projects are also acceptable, but not mandatory. Please do not send attachments bigger than 20 MB.

WHEN?

The application deadline is set on April 30, 23:59. The name of the winner will be communicated at the beginning of June. The exhibition will take place between September and October 2022.

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
